
Principal's Message

The students with Pre-medical backgrounds can opt for this degree fulfilling the admission criteria. During their stay at SCPS, the students study various subjects and go through practical training to qualify for the degree of Doctor of Pharmacy. This degree is recognized by the Pharmacy Council of Pakistan and is widely accepted nationally and internationally.

• The candidate should have passed the Intermediate Science (F.Sc) Examination (Medical Group), or an equivalent examination from a Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education in Pakistan;

OR

• the candidate should have passed an examination of a foreign institution or examining body, which is equivalent to the Intermediate (F. Sc) Examination (Medical Group) of a Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education in Pakistan. Equivalence to be determined by Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC).













